


Removal

- 1. Turn the fuel valve OFF.
- 2. Remove the seat (page 36).
- 3. Remove the shroud A bolts/collars (1).
- 4. Remove the shroud B bolts (2) and shrouds (3).

- 5. Pull the breather tube (4) out of steering stem nut.
- 6. Unhook and remove the fuel tank band (5).
- 7. Unhook the air cleaner cover rubber (6).
- 8. Remove the fuel tank bolt/collar (7).




- (4) breather tube

- 9. Disconnect the fuel line (8) from the fuel valve (9). The fuel line leading to the carburetor must be disconnected, not the fuel line leading to the fuel tank.
- 10. Remove the fuel valve bolt (10) and fuel valve.
- 11. Remove the fuel tank.

A WARNING

Gasoline is highly flammable and explosive. You can be burned or seriously injured when handling fuel.

- Stop the engine and keep heat, sparks and flame away.
- Handle fuel only outdoors.
- Wipe up spills immediately.
