Starting a Warm Engine

Start a warm engine in the same manner as a cold engine, but do not use the fuel mixture enrichment lever (keep the lever raised).

WARNING:

 Exhaust contains poisonous carbon monoxide. Never run the engine in a closed garage or confined area.

BREAK-IN PROCEDURE

During the first 600 miles (1,000 km), operate your new MT-250 so the engine neither pulls laboriously nor exceeds 80% of the maximum rpm in any gear. Avoid full throttle operation, and select your gear changes to spare the engine undue stress. Careful break-in operating during the initial mileage will measurably extend the service life of the engine.
