
SPARK PLUG

(Refer to the maintenance precautions on page 51, 52).

Recommended plug:

CR9EH-9 (NGK), U27FER-9 (ND)

- Disconnect the spark plug cap from the spark plug.
- Clean any dirt from around the spark plug base. Remove the spark plug using the plug wrench furnished in the tool kit.



- (1) Spark plug gap
- (2) Side electrode

- 3. Inspect the electrodes and center porcelain for deposits, erosion or cabon fouling. If the erosion or deposit is heavy, replace the plug. Clean a carbon or wet-fouled plug with a plug cleaner, otherwise use a wire brush.
- 4. Check the spark plug gap (1) using a wiretype feeler gauge. If adjustment is necessary, bend the side electrode (2) carefully.

The gap should be:

0.8-0.9 mm (0.031-0.035 in)

Make sure the plug washer is in good condition.
