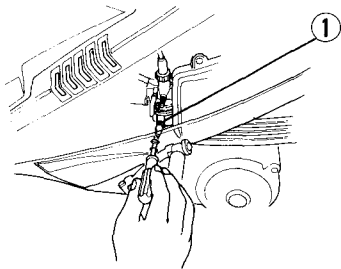


TRANSPORTING

▲ WARNING

- * To prevent the possibility of a fire or explosion when transporting the motorcycle, always:
 - Drain the fuel tank and carburetor.
 - Carry the motorcycle upright in its normal riding position to prevent oil and battery electrolyte from leaking.



(1) Drain screw

Draining Fuel

Perform this operation only in a well-ventilated area.

▲ WARNING

- * **Petrol is flammable and is explosive under certain conditions. Do not smoke or allow flames or sparks in the area when draining or refueling.**
1. Stop the engine.
 2. Empty the fuel tank using a commercially available hand siphon or other equivalent way.
 3. Place the free end of the carburetor drain tube in a suitable container.
 4. Open the carburetor drain by turning the drain screw (1) counterclockwise. When all the fuel has drained, turn the screw clockwise until tight.
