

6. Wash the filter in nonflammable or high flash point solvent and allow it to dry thoroughly.

⚠ WARNING

POTENTIAL HAZARD

Using gasoline or low flash point solvents for cleaning ATV parts.

WHAT CAN HAPPEN

A fire or explosion could result.

HOW TO AVOID THE HAZARD

Use only a nonflammable or high flash point solvent for cleaning ATV parts.

7. Soak the filter in Pro Honda Foam Filter oil or an equivalent until saturated, then squeeze out the excess oil.

CAUTION:

Do not twist the filter element when squeezing out excess oil. Twisting could damage the filter.

8. Reassemble by reversing the disassembly sequence.
