- 2. Remove the seat (page 144).
- 3. Remove the rear fender lid (page 123).
- 4. Remove the fuse box cover (page 125).
- 5. Pull the old fuse out of the clips.
- 6. Push a new fuse into the clips and install the fuse box cover.
- 7. Install the rear fender lid.
- 8. Install the seat.




Fig. 4-22 (1) Sub fuses

## **AWARNING**

## POTENTIAL HAZARD

Improperly replacing a fuse.

## WHAT CAN HAPPEN

Serious damage to the electrical system, which could cause a fire or a loss of lights or engine power, which could lead to an accident.

## HOW TO AVOID THE HAZARD

Never use a fuse with a different rating from that specified in this Owner's Manual.

Do not pry the clips open to get a fuse out, as a loose fuse could cause damage to the electrical system or start a fire.
