Adjusting Idle Speed

NOTE:

Do not try to compensate for faults in other systems by adjusting the carburetor.




Fig. 4-9 (1) Throttle stop screw

Before adjusting the idle speed and air-fuel mixture, unsnap the right side cover. (Fig. 4-9)

To adjust the idle speed:

- 1. Warm up the engine. The engine must be warm for accurate idle adjustment. Ten minutes of stop-and-go riding is sufficient.
- 2. Adjust idle speed by turning the throttle stop screw (Fig. 4-9). Idle Speed:

1,400 \pm 100 rpm
