

## **Engine Oil & Filter**

5. Reinstall the oil filter cover, making sure the bolts are tightened to the specified torque:

7 lbf-ft (10 N·m, 1.0 kgf·m)

- 6. Install the right engine sub cover.
- 7. Pour the drained oil into a suitable container and dispose of it in an approved manner (page 180).

## **NOTICE**

Improper disposal of drained fluids is harmful to the environment.

## Add Engine Oil:

- 1. Check that the drain plug sealing washer is in good condition. If necessary, replace the sealing washer.
- 2. Reinstall the oil drain plug and tighten it to the specified torque:  $18 \text{ lbf-ft} (25 \text{ N} \cdot \text{m}, 2.5 \text{ kgf} \cdot \text{m})$
- 3. Fill the crankcase with the recommended grade oil approximately: 2.5 US qt (2.4  $\ell$ )
- 4. Reinstall the oil filler cap/dipstick.
- 5. Start the engine and let it idle for 3-5 minutes.
- 6. Stop the engine, wait 2-3 minutes and check the oil level. Make sure the oil is between the upper and lower level marks on the oil filler cap/dipstick. If necessary, add more oil but do not overfill.
- 7. Check that there are no oil leaks.
- 8. Install the left engine sub cover.

If a torque wrench is not used for installation, see your Honda dealer as soon as possible to verify proper assembly.

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
