
- 3. To remove the spark plug from the front cylinder, remove the front cowl (page 50) and inner cowl (page 51).
- 4. Remove the oil cooler mounting bolts (4).
- 5. Remove the spark plug with the spark plug wrench.




- (3) Oil cooler

- 6. Inspect the electrodes and center porcelain for deposits, erosion or cabon fouling. If the erosion or deposit is heavy, replace the plug. Clean a carbon or wetfouled plug with a plug cleaner, otherwise use a wire brush.
- 7. Check the spark plug gap (5) using a wire-type feeler gauge. If adjustment is necessary, bend the side electrode (6) carefully.

The gap should be:

0.80-0.90 mm (0.031-0.035 in)
Make sure the plug washer is in good condition.
