
Fuel Tank

Fuel tank capacity is 9.5% (2.5 US gal) including 2.0% (0.5 US gal) in the reserve supply. To open the filler cap (1), pull out the breather tube (2) from the steering stem nut. Then turn the filler cap counterclockwise.

Any automotive gasoline with a pump octane number $(\frac{R+M}{2})$ of 86 or higher, or a research octane number of 91 or higher may be used. If "knocking" or "pinging" occurs, try a different brand of gasoline or a higher octane grade.

After refueling, be sure to tighten the fuel filler cap firmly by turning clockwise. Insert the breather tube into the steering stem nut.

WARNING

- * Gasoline is extremely flammable and is explosive under certain conditions. Refuel in a well ventilated area with the engine stopped. Do not smoke or allow open flames or sparks in the area where the motorcycle is refueled or where gasoline is stored.
- * Do not overfill the tank (there should be no fuel in the filler neck). After refueling, make sure the filler cap is closed securely.
- * Avoid repeated or prolonged contact with skin or breathing of vapor. KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

CAUTION

* Gasoline may damage paint of the air cleaner cover. Avoid contact with the surface of the air cleaner cover.
