If a label comes off or becomes hard to read, contact your dealer for a replacement.

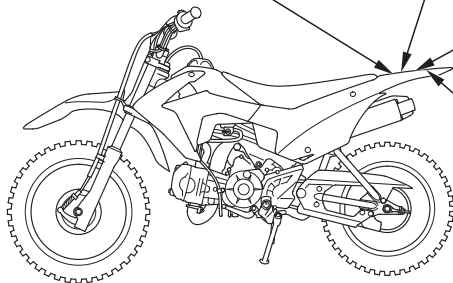
