

## Pre-ride Inspection

To ensure safety, it is your responsibility to perform a pre-ride inspection and make sure that any problem you find is corrected. A pre-ride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tyre, can be a major inconvenience.

Check the following items before you get on your vehicle:

- Fuel level - Fill fuel tank when necessary. ➔ P. 27
- Throttle - Check for smooth opening and full closing in all steering positions. ➔ P. 73
- Engine oil level - Add engine oil if necessary. Check for leaks. ➔ P. 57
- Coolant level - Add coolant if required. Check for leaks. ➔ P. 61

- Drive chain - Check condition and slack, adjust and lubricate if necessary. ➔ P. 67
- Brakes - Check operation;  
Front and Rear: check brake fluid level and pads wear. ➔ P. 63, ➔ P. 64
- Lights and horn - Check that lights, indicators and horn function properly.
- Clutch - Check operation;  
Adjust freeplay if necessary. ➔ P. 71
- Wheels and tyres - Check condition, air pressure and adjust if necessary. ➔ P. 43
