
## **7.** GL1800/D/DA

Support your motorcycle securely and raise the rear wheel off the ground using the center stand or a hoist.

## GL1800B/BD

Support your motorcycle securely and raise the rear wheel off the ground using a maintenance stand or a hoist.

**8.** Remove the rear wheel nuts, and remove the rear wheel.



## Installation

- **1.** To install the rear wheel, reverse the removal procedure.
- **2.** Install the rear wheel and tighten the rear wheel nuts equally in the crisscross pattern in two or three steps.

**Torque:** 80 lbf·ft (108 N·m, 11.0 kgf·m)

- **3.** Install the parts in the reverse order of removal.
- **4.** Check that the wheel rotates freely.

If a torque wrench was not used for installation, see your dealer as soon as possible to verify proper assembly. Improper assembly may lead to loss of braking capacity.
