Tires and wheels	Check the air pressure (≥ P. 89), examine tread for wear and damage (≥ P. 89), and check the wheels for damage.	
Fluid levels	Check the engine oil level ( $\blacktriangleright$ P. 102), engine coolant level ( $\triangleright$ P. 108), and brake fluid level ( $\triangleright$ P. 110).	
Lights	Check that the headlight, position lights, brake light, taillight, license plate light and turn signals are working properly.	
Controls	Check the freeplay of the clutch lever (NC700X NC750XA) ( $\supseteq$ P. 119) and throttle grip ( $\supseteq$ P. 122), Check the front brake lever ( $\supseteq$ P. 126), rear brake pedal and parking brake (NC700XD NC750XD) ( $\supseteq$ P. 112) operate properly.	
Drive chain	Check the slack ( $\blacksquare$ P. 115), adjust the slack ( $\blacksquare$ P. 116), and lubricate ( $\blacksquare$ P. 87) as needed.	
Fuses	Check that you have a full supply of spare fuses.	
Nuts & bolts	Check the major nuts and bolts, and tighten as needed.
