**Be Prepared**

- Fasten seat belts.
- Wear an approved helmet and protective gear.
- Clear seats and footrests before driving.
- Each rider must be able to sit in a designated seating position with back against seat, feet flat on foot, and hands on steering wheel or handrails. One controller inside the vehicle.

**Drive Responsibly**

Avoidance of control and throttle.

- Avoid steep descents, sideways driving, backing, or hitting, and never do double.
- Slow down before entering a turn.
- Avoid front-end collision when turning, even from a stop.
- Plan for 18" rough terrain, ruts, and other changes in traction and terrain. Avoid paved surfaces. Avoid wet (18") riding across ditches.

**Be Sure Riders Pay Attention and Plan Ahead**

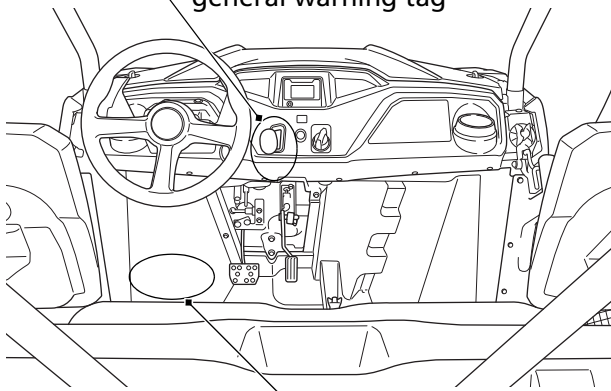
- If you drink or feel the vehicle may tip or roll, reduce your risk of injury.
- Keep arms up on the steering wheel or handrails and knees pointed.
- Do not put any part of your body outside of the vehicle for any reason.

**Require Proper Use of Your Vehicle**

- Do your seat to prevent injury.
- Do not allow children to ride without training.
- Make sure operators are 16 or older.
- Do not allow to drive on roads other than off-road or closed.
- Do not allow operation on public roads (unless in an unimproved road designed for off-highway vehicle use) or on roads with open and traffic can occur.
- Do not exceed seating capacity: 1 driver, 1 passenger.

## Shift and Drive select Information

- To prevent drivetrain damage, bring the unit to a complete stop before operating the reverse lever and drive mode select lever. (2WD-4WD)
- After using the 2WD/4WD select lever, the mode may not mechanically engage until forward motion begins.
