## Is Your ATV Ready to Ride?

Tires

Nuts \& Bolts

Use a gauge to check the air pressure. Adjust if needed. Also look for signs of damage or excessive wear (page 130).

Check for damage or looseness (page 136).
Check the wheels to see that the axle nuts are tightened. Use a wrench to make sure all accessible nuts, bolts, and fasteners are tight.

Underbody \& Exhaust Check for, and remove, any dirt, vegetation System

Air Cleaner Housing Drain Tube

or other debris that could be a fire hazard or interfere with the proper operation of the vehicle.

Check for deposits in the drain tube. If necessary, clean the tube (page 103) and check the air cleaner housing.

Walk around your ATV and look for anything that appears unusual, such as a leak or loose cable.

Check the cable housings for wear. Check the fittings for looseness. Replace or tighten as needed.

Make sure the headlight, brake light and taillight are working properly.
