
If You Have a Flat Tire

- 10. While holding the other end of the rear axle shaft (15) with a wrench, remove the rear axle nut (16).
- 11. Pull the rear axle shaft out and remove the side collar.
- 12. Move the wheel to the right to separate it from the final drive gear case.
- 13. Remove the wheel.

Wheel Installation

Before installing the wheel, check that the wheel hub and final drive gear splines are coated with molybdenum disulfide paste (USA only: Pro Honda Moly 60 Paste, or equivalent).

- Position the wheel between the swingarm and the final drive gear case.
 Be sure the splines on the wheel hub fit into the final drive gear case.
- 2. Install the side collar into the brake panel.
- Insert the rear axle shaft from the right side, through the right swingarm, brake panel, wheel hub and final drive gear case.
