Pre-ride Inspection

To ensure safety, it is your responsibility to perform a pre-ride inspection and make sure that any problem you find is corrected. A preride inspection is a must, not only for safety, but because having a breakdown, or even a flat tyre, can be a major inconvenience.

Check the following items before you get on your motorcycle:

- Fuel level-Fill fuel tank when necessary. ▶ P. 32
- Throttle-Check for smooth opening and full closing in all steering positions. P. 79
- Engine oil level-Add engine oil if necessary. Check for leaks. ➡ P. 58
- Drive chain-Check condition and slack, adjust and lubricate if necessary. ■ P. 72

• Brakes-Check operation;

- Lights and horn-Check that lights, indicators and horn function properly.
- Clutch-Check operation; Adjust freeplay if necessary. ► P. 76
- Wheels and tyres-Check condition, air pressure and adjust if necessary. P. 48
