
REAR BRAKE PAD REPLACEMENT


Check the brake
fluid level in the
brake master cylinder reservoir as this
operation causes
the level to rise.

Push the cal
caliper bod
brake pads.

Check the brake Push the caliper piston all the way in by pushing the fluid level in the caliper body inward to allow installation of new ake master cylin-brake pads.



Remove the pad pin. Remove the caliper mounting bolt.




Pivot the caliper up, and remove the brake pads.



Clean the inside of the caliper especially around the caliper piston.

Make sure the pad spring is in place.
